In what year was the Guard House built? **ANSWER: 1892**

What was the Guard House used for? **ANSWER: To lock up insubordinates**

### **YOU ARE NOW INSTRUCTED TO FIND THE GARRISON BARRACKS. (NO.4 ON MAP)**

How many men lived in the Barracks? **ANSWER: 28 men**

In what year was the Barracks extended? **ANSWER: 1899**

How many men could the entire Barracks now house? **ANSWER: 42**

### **MARCH TO THE CONVOY WALK AND FIND THE HERITAGE ROSE GARDEN. (NO. 14 ON MAP)**

What is the name of the type of rose grown in this garden?

**ANSWER: Rugosa Or Rugged Rose**

**(NO. 15 ON YOUR MAP) Eyes right...** How many chimneys can you see on top of the building? **ANSWER: 3 Chimneys**

What is the name of this building and in what year was it built?

**ANSWER: Married Quarters built in 1899**

### **HEADING UP OR DOWN THE CONVOY WALK, FIND THE FOLLOWING:**

First Convoy. HMAT Karroo. What is the letter and number of this ship and how many horses did it carry on board?

**ANSWER: A10 and 400 horses on board**

Second Convoy. A40. What is the name of this ship and how many Officers were on board?

**ANSWER: HMAT Ceramic and 72 Officers on board**

**ANSWER: Warrant Officer's Quarters**

**WALK TO NO.20 ON YOUR MAP.**

What is the name of this building? **ANSWER: Underground Magazine**

How many shells was it designed to store?

**ANSWER: 400 shells**

**GOING TO THE RIGHT AROUND THE UNDERGROUND MAGAZINE, FOLLOW YOUR MAP TO THE TOP OF THE CONVOY LOOKOUT WHERE YOU WILL FIND THE FLAG POLE & SIGNAL MAST. (NO. 18)**

How many large green gun emplacements did you see? **ANSWER: 2**

What is the name of the flag on top of the flag pole?

**ANSWER: Australian Flag**

Finding the 1891 Historic Survey Marker (No. 19 on your map), list the 'South' co-ordinates on the marker.

**ANSWER: 35'.02'.00"**

What is the name of the long blue/grey coloured torpedo?

**ANSWER: Mark VIII Torpedo**
